There Is One Gospel on Which We Stand

A wonderful song that we sing together on Sunday mornings is called, "There Is One Gospel." Verse One of this song says:

There is one Gospel on which I stand for all eternity. It is my story, my Father's plan. The Son has rescued me.

Oh what a Gospel, Oh what a peace.
My highest joy and my deepest need.
Now and forever He is my light.
I stand in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

This wonderful, true Gospel is what we have been looking at and reflecting on quite a bit lately at our church. Pastor Adam started preaching through the book of Galatians in January & it has been so encouraging to be reminded that there is no other gospel than the One True Gospel of Jesus Christ that we see clearly in the Scriptures.

We have been seeing reminders from Paul in Galatians that our salvation does not depend on our own works or righteousness. Our salvation is accomplished by God's work of justification, and as Pastor Adam has had us declare together on Sunday mornings: *Justification is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone, for the glory of God alone.*

Here are some wonderful reminders from Pastor Adam's sermons in Galatians so far: God's Word trumps man's word and we as a church need His Word. We want to be a church that reject's man's gospel and remembers that we can't be people pleasers and servants of Christ. God grants us peace and grace in the Gospel because Jesus gave Himself for our sins. Remember that there is no other gospel & that distorted gospels are no gospel at all. Distorted gospels sabotage true gospel ministry, lead to slavery, and those who distort the gospel are accursed.

As we continue to sit together under the Word of God in Galatians on Sunday mornings, may we do what Pastor Adam has encouraged us to do as a church: Reflect upon our lives before Jesus & Rejoice in God's call upon our lives. May we continue to reject man's distorted gospels, uniting & standing together as a church around the One True Gospel & Scriptures, "that the truth of the Gospel might be preserved in us" (Galatians 2:5)





